


7. Operating Description

1. Visitor Call & Monitoring



- When you push the [CALL] button on Camera, you can hear the chime sound from the monitor, sub-interphone, and Camera No. as well as visitor's picture will be shown on a screen.(Duration of on-screen: 30 sec)
- You can pick up the handset if you want to talk. If the screen is off while you're talking, you can push [MONITOR] button in order to speak again. (Duration of talking: 60 sec)
- After checking visitors, you can push [OPEN] button to open the door, while you press the button, the relay connection of door camera will be sustained.
- □ Press the [MONITOR] button to see condition of the door in standby state, and press the [RIGHT (▶)] or LEFT (◄) button to see the screen of next camera.
- While you are talking with door camera or you're monitoring, the door will be open if you press [OPEN] button.
- While talking or monitoring over the camera, you may store 1 cut, by pressing the REC/IMAGE button

2. Interphone



- □ When you pick up the handset and press the [INTERPHONE/ •] button, you can hear the call sound from Sub interphone and Monitor. Then you can start talking
- In order to open the door from interphone, you can press door open [OPEN] button, and while you press the button, the relay connection of door camera will be sustained.

3. Picture Memory

3-1 Recording Manual

While you are monitoring outside the house with CDV-71BE or talking though door phone, you can press the [REC./DEL.] button to save 1 cut of picture thru the door camera or CCTV camera.

3-2 Auto recording

- Record a visitor picture on the memory of CDV-71BE when you set the units on AWAY mode
- □ Press [REC./DEL.] button before moving green box "ON" and then press [...].



☐ The Green Lamp on the top of CDV-71BE will blink on the function of Auto Recording.

3-3 Erase a memory pictures.

□ Press [REC./DEL.] button and then using [LEFT/RIGHT] button move to the green box to "YES" Then press [...] button.







Review function

- □ This function is to see the stored screens.
- □ Stored screens are shown per 6 screens and you can see 6 cuts in order with [REVIEW] button.




- You can select one of the 6 images of visitors picture recorded on screen using the [UP▲]/[DOWN▼] and [LEFT ◀/[RIGHT▶] buttons,
- \square Press [\square] button after moving the red bar to the image you want to enlarge.



- □ Press [LEFT ◀]/[RIGHT ▶] button, you can see the pictures enlarged in order.
- □ Press [REVIEW] button to turn on stand by mode.
- □ An additional screen to be stored after completion of 128 cut stores, the screen is stored
 1st image of 128 cut stores and 128th image will erase automatically in the memory

5. Time setting

- □ It is set to store the time when the screen is stored in the image memory
- □ Press [TIME] button then using [DOWN▼] button and [LEFT ◀]/ [RIGHT▶] button to change a number.



 \Box Press [\bot] button to save time and turn to stand by.

6. Screen Adjustment

- ☐ These functions allow the user to make desired screen adjustments.
- ☐ While monitoring the entrance, you can access the CONTROL MENU by holding the ENT button.
- □ Using the [UP△]/[DOWN▽] buttons, scroll the rindicator to the desired setting you wish to change. Press the [RIGHT▷] button to make the level adjustment bar appear.
- □ Use the [UP△]/[DOWN▽] buttons to adjust to the desired level, and press the [RIGHT▷] button to return to the menu.

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- □ Other display adjustments are made in the same manner as detailed above.
- □ If you wish to change the ratio of the screen, select 'Disp. Ratio' from the menu and press the [RIGHT |>] button. Push the [UP |△]/[DOWN |□] buttons to change the ratio from (FULL & 4:3).







□ If you want to change the initial value of the screen adjustment, push the [RIGHT▷] button after selecting 'Reset', and the value will return to its default setting.





- ☐ Green box status stands for camera in use and Red box status stands for camera not in use.
- ☐ You can move to stand-by mode after finishing the setting
- ☐ The default value is set to use all 4 cameras after production.
